

Sarah E. Walker





Event Material

The event program shown was created for Kennedy Heights Arts Center's annual Fall Back event. Each year, they celebrate a different decade and pull inspiration from Cincinnati history. I gathered information from an underground newspaper in operation during the 60s. Using articles, comics, and letter clippings from The Independent Eye, I created a program detailing the event while also celebrating the work of locals during this time period. This project was a great way to immerse myself in the local community while also creating a unique program for a highly anticipated community event.
